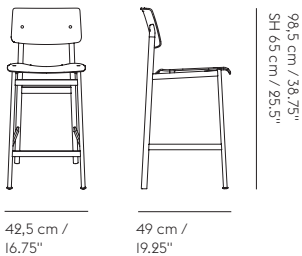




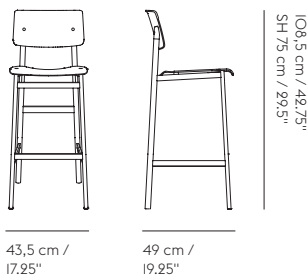
LOFT COUNTER & BAR STOOL

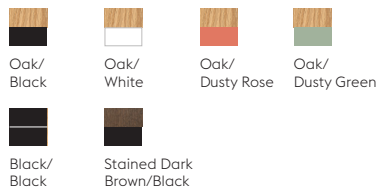

DESCRIPTION

Combining the ideas of Scandinavian materiality and industrial design, the Loft Counter & Bar Stool features contrasting materials with its frame in powder coated steel that is offset by the warmth of wood with clear or colored PU lacquer.

PRODUCTION PROCESS

The seat and backrest are made with wood veneer, which have been lacquered with either a clear or colored PU lacquer. The Stained Dark Brown version is treated with water-based lacquer. The frame is made of welded steel finished with an extra durable acrylic powder coating.

MATERIAL

Back and seat in veneer with a beech core and an oak veneer top with PU lacquer. Frame in powder coated steel.

For Stained Dark Brown version only: Back and seat with water-based lacquer. Please note that slight color variations can occur due to the inherent characteristics of the material.

CLEANING AND CARE

Wipe off with moist cloth and remove excess liquid with dry cloth. This product can be cleaned with alcohol disinfectant. However, please note that as wooden products will get patina where the surface color can slightly fade. If cleaning is uneven, this may become even more apparent yet the lacquer will stay in place. For wooden products in lighter colors, the patina will be less apparent.

SPARE PARTS

Pre-mounted plastic glides included. Felt and plastic glides can be purchased separately.

MADE-TO-ORDER

Option of upholstered seat in approved textiles from Kvadrat or leather from premium leather suppliers.
